Developing a New International Training Program for the Thirty Meter Telescope

Ms. Lisa Hunter

Institute for Scientist and Engineer Educators (ISEE), University of California, Santa Cruz



Lisa Hunter is the founder and Director of ISEE, and has directed it since its inception in 2001, when she was the Education Director at the Center for Adaptive Optics. She manages internship programs for college students, and professional development programs for graduate students and postdoctoral researchers. She works closely with scientists and engineers to increase opportunities through effective education, mentoring, and partnerships that bridge academia, industry, government, and community organizations, both nationally and internationally. Currently, she is working with the Thirty Meter Telescope International Observatory (TIO) to design a pilot program aimed at serving the needs of TIO partners and communities. Hunter has many publications, and serves on a number of national committees, including the Association of Universities for Research in Astronomy (AURA) Workforce and Diversity Committee.

Abstract

The Institute for Scientists and Engineer Educators (ISEE) is working with the Thirty Meter Telescope International Observatory (TIO) community to design a prototype international internship program that would provide a unique opportunity for training tomorrow's scientific and technological leaders, while also cultivating productive international partnerships. The goals in the design phase of this project include developing a collaborative structure across the TIO partnership to construct a conceptual design for a program that will be useful to all of the TIO partners and meet their needs and expectations for an international TIO workforce development program. This talk is aimed at stimulating interest and input from TIO partners in China.
