Prof. Leopoldo Infante (Universidad Catolica of Chile)



Professor Leopoldo Infante is currently director of the Centre for Astro-Engineering at Universidad Catolica of Chile and President of the Chilean Astronomical Society (SOCHIAS). He received his PhD of Physics/Astronomy from the University of Victoria in 1995. He was the Director of Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile Astronomy and Astrophysics Department from 2000 to 2006. His research areas are birth and evolution of structures in the universe stellar populations.

Abstract

I will begin talking about astronomy in Chile and its potential to become the



astronomical world capital. Then, I will describe the The Cluster Lensing and Supernova Survey with Hubble (CLASH) survey of the most distant galaxies ever detected. I will discuss new results and future prospects for finding galaxies at redshifts higher than 10.
