## Introduction to China-Chile joint Astronomy Center

### Prof. Jiasheng Huang (CfA/NAOC)



Dr. Jiasheng Huang is a Professor of the National Astronomical Observatories (NAO) of the CAS and the US Harvard-Smithsonian Center for Astrophysics. He also leads China-Chile astronomical cooperation for the NAO of the CAS. He obtained his Ph.D. of Astronomy from the

University of Hawaii in 1997. After which He did a 3-year post-doctoral fellowship in Max-Planck Institute of Astronomy. Then he joined the Spitzer/IRAC Science team, Smithsonian Astrophysical Obs in 1999.

### Abstract

I will present a summary on the newly established China-Chile joint Center for astronomy, and the joint research projects and postdoc programs between both countries. The China-Chile collaboration started years ago, yet just have had significant progress after the



IAU Beijing Assembly. We have been awarded 17m RMB as an initiative to set up this center, and expect a similar amount of funding for next year. We hope that Chinese astronomers can access the telescope facilities in Chile through this collaboration. In this talk, I will leave plenty time to answer questions and carry out discussions on the China-Chile collaborations.
